

GRANDE ALBERONE PROSECCO DOC BRUT

Wine

Type	White sparkling wine
Growing region	Veneto
Grape varieties	Glera
Characteristics	Bright straw yellow with a fine and persistent perlage. On the nose, there are some intense scents floral notes and elegant hints of white fruit. Harmonious and mouth-filling, with nice freshness and fine structure.
Winemaking	Grapes are crushed, then softly pressed, in order to extract only the best must. First fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature (16-18°C). Then, the addition of selected yeasts is followed by the second fermentation in sealed steel tanks [Charmat method].
Alcohol	11%

Soil	clay-limestone
Orientation and altitude	South, South-East, 150-180m a.s.l.
Planting system	vertical trellis, Guyot pruning
Vineyard Plant Density	4.000 grapevines/hectare

Recommendation

Preservation	Keep in a cool dry place
Service temperature	8-10°C
Glass	Tulip
Aging Potential	12 - 18 months if stored in the right place
Best served with	An excellent aperitif to enjoy in company. Great when paired with appetizer, grilled fish, and desserts.
